The Mayor and Council Members met in regular session on **Thursday, October 3, 2024** at 4:00 p.m. with Mayor Butler presiding and the following present:

Mr. Jimbo Graham gave update of the Richard A. Butler Memorial Fire Station. Construction at 61% complete and that 20% of the project will occur in the last weeks related to furnishings & equipment. Also, Brookwood Subdivision Sewer System Improvements “Substantially Complete”. The PHMSA Gas System Improvements are ongoing, with Topographic Survey completed and gave update on the Woodworth Environs Regional Sewer Collections System application.

Ord. No. 01-24, pertaining to the **Bond Ordinance**, public hearing was opened for input, there was none, therefore public hearing was closed, upon motion by Council Member Kitchen, seconded by Council Member Reich, said ordinance was adopted.

Res. No. 1911-24, pertaining to **Brookwood Subdivision Sewer Improvement**, was made by Council Member **Aymond**, seconded by Council Member **Reich**, thus passing by unanimous vote.

Res. No. 1912-24, pertaining to **Police Policy & Procedural Manuel – Security & Awareness & Training**, was made by Council Member **Reich**, seconded by Council Member **Kitchen**, thus passing by unanimous vote.

The Mayor, Fire Chief and Chief of Police all provided monthly reports.

Upon motion by Council Member **Reich**, seconded by Council Member **Aymond**, the town meeting was adjourned by unanimous vote.
