

RULES & REGULATIONS INDIAN CREEK RECREATION AREA

Obey All Park Rules or Be Evicted

CAMPsites:

- Camping and trailer sites will be assigned by reservations.
- One RV or tent and two vehicles per site. Park in your assigned site only.
- No campers or camper units will be accepted after permanently designated campsite accommodations are full.
- Tent camping and trailers are permitted only on designated campsites.
- Camper may occupy a particular site for a maximum of 14 days. Minimum waiting period for re-occupation of same site is seven (7) days except during winter months.
- No camping units, boats, utility trailers or other equipment will be left unattended longer than 48 hours without notifying the park management.
- Service buildings are for the use and convenience of all campers and trailer occupants. No supplementary structures permitted.
- Campsites must be kept clean and neat at all times; please – No littering or cigarette butts on the grounds. Put trash in dumpsters.
- Sewage and water from campers shall be disposed of at the disposal dump.
- No sanitary napkins or tampons can be placed in the bathhouse toilets or disposed of in our dump station due to the system we are currently under.
- No loud music that may disturb your neighbor.
- No vehicle repair or oil change on site.
- Clotheslines or any articles placed outside for drying will not be permitted. Our laundries are open 24 hours.
- Washing of vehicles not permitted on site.
- No generators allowed in the improved camping area 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM.
- Campers' visitors will not be admitted into the park after 10:00 PM. If camper is expecting late arrival (after 10:00 PM) to camp, the front office must be notified prior to 10:00 PM.
- Visitors must register at the office and overnight guests are charged.

CHECK-OUT:

- Check-out time for overnight campers is 2:00 PM.
- If not checked out by 2:00 PM, you will be charged an additional day.
- Upon departure, campers will leave campsite as it was found.

QUIET TIME:

- Quiet time will be observed in the overnight camping area from 10:00 PM until 7:00 AM. Radios, phonographs, television sets and musical instruments will not be played during these hours. No person or pets will be permitted to disturb the peace and quiet of others. **BANDS OR AMPLIFIED MUSIC ARE PROHIBITED.**

CHILDREN:

- Parents are responsible for the actions and safety of their children. Young children must be accompanied by an adult while using our facilities.
- Persons under 18 years of age are not permitted to stay overnight unless supervised by a responsible adult.
- Persons under 18 years of age are not permitted to use restrooms or bathhouses without the supervision of an adult.

PETS:

- Pets must be kept on a leash or in a cage at all times. No pets allowed in beach areas or park buildings.
- Barking dogs will not be tolerated. No exotic pets.
- Horses and other livestock are prohibited.

GENERAL:

- The speed limit is 15 MPH and reduces to 10 MPH through the Campsite areas.
- The use of illegal drugs will not be tolerated in this park. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is allowed only at a campsite by adults of legal drinking age according to state law. Open drunkenness is never permitted. Please don't use profanity.
- Emergency messages will be delivered to your site. All others must be picked up at the office.
- Fires will be restricted to fire pits or grills in campsite areas and should be attended at all times.
- Dumpsters are located on Azalea Trail. All trash from campsites must be carried to the dumpsters before guests leave the park.
- Day use areas/beaches close at 7:00 PM.
- Swim at all beaches at your own risk. No glass containers.
- Only electric golf cart use is allowed with registration at the office.
- Use of unlicensed motorized vehicles restricted. Contact Park Office for details.
- Golf cart drivers must be at least 18 years of age to operate.
- No golf cart driving between 10 PM to 7 AM.
- Cutting, digging, damaging or otherwise mutilating trees, shrubs and other plants for firewood or other reasons is prohibited. Do not put any nails into trees.
- Permittee waives and releases all claims against the State of Louisiana for any damage to person or property arising from the exercises of the privileges granted by this permit due to Act of God (lightning, wind, storm damage, tree falling).
- **PERMITTEE AGREES TO PAY THE STATE OF LOUISIANA FOR ANY DAMAGE RESULTING FROM THEIR MISUSE OF THE PREMISES.**
- Once you have paid for a site, you will not be allowed to move. If you move without park approval, you will forfeit any additional nights you paid on the first site.
- No portable pools or slip-and-slides.
- No fireworks in park.
- No dependant camp units on grounds.
- No pallets to be burned on property.
- No electric scooters or battery operated toy vehicles.
- No metal detectors anywhere on the premises.

The management reserves the right to evict anyone for infractions of rules or offensive behavior. Management also reserves the right to add to these rules at any time.
