## HOW TO ENTER

## **Rules and Regulations**

- Each team will be limited to a maximum of (5) Five people with one person assigned as team captain. Team Captains are responsible for their team members.
- This event is RAIN OR SHINE and entry fees are non-refundable
- Each team is responsible for their equipment and utensils to both boil and serve up to (2) two pounds of its crawfish to the judges. Examples of utensils and equipment include, but not limited to, boiling pots, boiling baskets, propane, ice chests, ice, burners, knives, chopping boards, tables, chairs, garbage bags, paper or plastic serving boats, paper, etc.
- Each team is welcome to provide additional fixings to their crawfish menu of corn, potatoes, sausages and onions to increase their chances of winning.plastic plates, napkins, paper towels, etc...
- Propane tanks or fuel tanks shall be in good working order and within code as per federal and state standards and regulations.
- Teams must be confirmed and paid by Friday, April 8, 2023 at 5:00pm. The entry fee is \$250. For this fee, the team will be provided 2 sacks of crawfish and get (5) Five event admission tickets.

- Teams may bring their own coolers into the cook-off area for their own consumption ONLY. Event Directors reserve the right to inspect coolers at any time while on the event grounds. Teams and their members agree to not distribute any contents of the team's coolers to anyone other than their own team members. If you are caught in violation of this, it will result in immediate disqualification and ejection from the venue.
- No outside alcoholic beverages will be allowed into the event or cooking areas. If you are caught in violation of this, it will result in immediate disqualification.
- Venue opens at 8 a.m. Teams must have their meals fully plated, ready to be judged by 11 a.m. on the day of the event.
- Each team is responsible for maintaining clean and safe boiling and serving areas
- Dumping of crawfish pots onto grass or in unauthorized areas is strictly prohibited. Care must be taken to avoid spills. Crawfish peels should be thrown in garbage bins. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.
